At the regular February meeting held on February 26, 2026, Mr. Campbell reported attending the January 23 and February 13, 2026, Superintendent Executive Committee meetings via Zoom. Ohio Department of Developmental Disabilities updates included guidance on county boards requesting financial assistance and exit waivers, waiver updates with new SSA requirements for two home visits and one day service visit a year, BEST (Basic Employment Skills Training) is still on hold, sustainability work, and Targeted Case Management being properly tracked in the cost reports. Ohio Association of County Board updates on state funded waiver advocacy, interRAI training and sample names, new user guide for eligibility, and data collection needs for funding the future.

Director of Education Ryan Buck's report on receiving an email from the Ohio Department of Children and Youth (DCY) on Carroll County state fiscal year 2026 transition compliance feedback Local Educational Agency notification. "An early intervention service provider responsible for service coordination shall on or before, but not more than ten calendar days in advance of, the first day of February, May, August, and November of each year, identify each child turning three years of age within one year from the first day of the respective month and notify the local education agency where the child resides. Our analysis indicates that your county's compliance percentage for Notification to the LEA for February 1, 2026, is 100 percent."

Business Manager Ray Heaston educated Board members on the expense and revenue line items. The 2026 starting cash balance was \$8,625,381.71. The budget accounts for the Board approved half mill levy reduction 2026. He went over upcoming expenses that will come out of the permanent improvement fund. HVAC units and roof sections were replaced in the same year and due for replacement in 2029. The Board also purchased three buses in 2016. Buses normally are replaced every ten years. The plan is to purchase at least one in 2028.

- Approved payment of January bills in the General Funds account in the amount of \$112,868.71.
- Approved payment of January bills in the Residential Services account in the amount of \$149,580.06.
- Approved the Program Division Reports as presented.
- Approved Resolution 212026 to participate in Stark County School's Council of Governments Cooperative advertising and receiving bids for integrated school bus units for 2026.
- Approved Resolution 222026 the 2025 Annual Report which includes the required annual strategic plan progress report.
