At the regular January meeting held on January 25, 2024, Mr. Campbell attended the Superintendent Executive Committee meeting on January 12, 2024 via Zoom. The Ohio Department of Developmental Disabilities staff provided updates on American Rescue Plan Act grants, Implementation of Appendix K, Waiver redesign, Adult Day Services quality pilot projects, and accreditation. Ohio Association of County Board updates on legislation House Bill 321 and 344 and rule changes for Waiver funding.

Mr. Campbell informed the Board of the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) grant award of \$45,355.34 for People First Chapter trip to Washington D.C. for sixteen people, Academy for Leadership Abilities curriculum, and camp for eight youth and four adults. Carroll Hills Industries received a quality improvement grant award for Adult Day Services utilizing ARPA funds.

Ray Heaston did a review of 2023 revenue and expenses. The Board ended the year with expenses exceeding revenue by \$23,000.
