At the regular June meeting Mr. Campbell reported attending the Superintendent Executive Committee meeting via Zoom on June 12 via Zoom. The Ohio Department of Developmental Disabilities Director Lyndsay Nash was there to discuss individual technical assistance team updates, fiscal year 2027 county-board funded admission agreement to developmental centers, interRAI assessor training, and Southeast Ohio collaborative. Ohio Association of County Boards updates included legislative and Waiver Modernization. Other topics included county to county transfers, local service survey, Region one interest in tracking growth data, and summer conference.

Mr. Campbell reported the Board currently has eighty-eight Individual Options Waivers with seventy-two funded by the Board and the other sixteen funded by the Ohio Department of Developmental Disabilities. The Board matches forty-six Level One Waivers and three Self-Empowerment Life Funding Waivers. The current waiting list is four, however one person is in a developmental center and placement in the community remains unsuccessful. This person has been in the developmental center since January 23, 2020. The other three have been offered level one waivers with two in the process of being enrolled. The Board ceiling for Individual Options waivers of seventy-two may be too low.

Mr. Campbell met with Director Lyndsay Nash on 6-24-2026 at the Department of Developmental Disabilities (DODD) along with other Superintendents and Mid-East Ohio Regional Council (MEORC) staff. Region #5 and MEORC proposed partnering with DODD to address county boards failing levies which jeopardize Home and Community Based Services state wideness. The proposal was in conjunction with DODD proposal to create a Southeast pilot with ten county boards. The intent is standardizing Service and Support Administration across thirty county boards by using a Council of Government, shift match to DODD, keep SSA service at county board, and simplify the system for people and families with developmental disabilities.

Business Manager Ray Heaston is finalizing agreements with local school districts. He is working on sending out agreements to providers for two days vocational services limited to a year for those who are eighteen to fifty-nine years old and Adult Day services for those sixty or older. Sold van #72 for \$6,500. The Ohio Housing Network Abrahams Avenue house now has two residents.

- Approved Resolution 622026 to increase wages of identified positions to meet the median range report presented by Mid-East Ohio Regional Council.
- Approved Resolution 632026 to purchase a new van to replace van 72 in the amount of \$42,124.
- Approved SSA Director job description.

- Entered executive session at 6:11 pm to consider the employment of a public employee or official. Exited at 6:21pm with no action.
