At the regular May meeting held on May 25, 2023. Mr. Campbell attended the Superintendent Executive Committee Meeting on May 10, 2023 from 6:00 to 9:00 pm at the Easton Hilton. Alaina Bowers was there to present on STABLE accounts. Discussion was held on allowing parents and legally responsible family members to be paid care for their minor child, Direct Support Professional retention pay, requirement for a person served to be on the Board of Directors, and Waiver redesign work.

Mr. Campbell attended the Ohio Association of County Boards Spring conference held at Easton Hilton on May 11 and 12. He attended sessions on behavior support, healthy leadership, artificial intelligence and CHATGPT, Department of Children and Youth, building a culture of retention, setting SMART strategic human resources goals, and the Public Health Emergency wind down.

Mr. Campbell has been working with Darin Durbin from Ohio Network for Innovations (ONI). Currently ONI is in the process of renovating Carroll County homes. Seventh Street home was successful with capital housing dollar request to the Ohio Department of Developmental Disabilities for new flooring, dry lock basement walls, paint interior walls, new countertop, exterior steps, siding, and roof. A request for new doors, roof, and ceiling repair is in process for Radar Avenue house. We are in the process of looking to purchase a house or build a new one to replace the two houses sold.
