

Carroll County Board of Developmental Disabilities

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At the regular May meeting Mr. Campbell reported attending the Superintendent Executive Committee meeting via Zoom on May 8. Greg Moody shared his experiences and insight from his former role as the Executive Director of Governor Kasich's Office of Health Transformation. Other topics included local service survey for county boards, and regional input on fiscal sustainability, Accreditation workgroup update, and survey from Executive Development Program.

Mr. Campbell attended the Ohio Association of County Boards spring conference held at Hilton Columbus downtown on May 21 and 22. Keynote speaker Kristen Cox encouraged county board to work on relationships with those served and help them to achieve positive outcomes. TOMBOT presented on pets for people who can't have pets. This will be a valuable resource for people with dementia.

Mr. Campbell received the intent to purchase agreement from Mid-East Ohio Regional Council (MEORC). He shared the board had cost savings of \$204,503 last year which was equivalent of three full time staff by purchasing services from MEORC.

Mr. Campbell also received the 2026 School Salary and Salary Comparison reports prepared by MEORC. He recommends employees should be at the median pay for each job description based on experience level. Teachers with master's degree and five or less years of tenure, Teachers with bachelor's degree and five or less years tenure, Preschool teachers, Classroom aides, and Assistant to the Superintendent were identified as below median. The Board had a three percent cost of living increase on February 3, 2025, and adjusted salary ranges on August 18, 2025.

- Approved payment of April bills in the General Funds account in the amount of 92,267.15.
- Approved payment of April bills in the Residential Services account in the amount of \$135,531.82.
- Approved the Program Division Reports as presented.
- Approved Resolution 522026 to use supported living funds to complete the whole house generator need for a medically fragile adult not to exceed \$5,000.
- Entered executive session at 6:18 pm to consider the employment of a public employee or official. Exited at 6:33 pm with no action.
