

# Carroll County Board of Developmental Disabilities

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At the regular August meeting held on August 22, 2024, Mr. Campbell attended the Superintendent Executive Committee Meeting on July 12, 2024, via Zoom. The Ohio Department of Developmental Disabilities provided updates on Accreditation Scoring Pilot, Hardship Rule, Direct Support Professional compensation surveys, and Waiting list rule, The Ohio Association of County Boards updates on Waiver Modernization, HB 465 Intermediate Care Facility monitoring bill language change to make video voluntary was voted out of committee, HB 512 for emergency certification for providers under the Ohio Children and Family Department was voted out of committee, HB 344 elimination of replacement tax was voted out of committee, HB 427 elimination of sub-minimum wage certificate language was added existing programs may apply for new certificate that will allow for a five year transition to minimum wage, and the Ohio Association of County Board's strategic plan.

Mr. Campbell attended the Service and Support Administrators Statewide meeting on August 7, 2024, via Zoom. Fifty eight percent of individuals now have individual service plans in Salesforce. The Ohio Department of Developmental Disabilities is now using a new tool for accreditation. County Boards need to be using Department of Job and Family service forms for due process. Service and Support Administrators need to visit out of county placements to ensure proper fit for individuals. New pilot for Station MD with the Ohio Department of Developmental Disabilities.

Mr. Campbell attended the Superintendent Summer Conference on August 8 and 9 at the Hocking Hills State Park Lodge and conference center. Day one covered TCM rates, SSA staffing, Waiver costs, fiscal sustainability, and fiscal projections. Day two was the Ohio Superintendents of County Boards Executive Committee meeting. Bylaws, business manager association, legislative updates, Department of Children and Youth, Ohio Rise and Early Intervention were topics of discussion. 14c the elimination of subminimum wage was discussed with proposal of a draft delegate resolution. The Department of Children and Youth are requesting budget coalition priorities.

Mid-East Ohio Regional Council is working on completing the draft Strategic Plan for 2025 to 2027 for the Board. The plan is for the draft to be presented at the September Board meeting for approval.
