
Carroll County Board of Developmental Disabilities

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At the regular August meeting held on August 28, 2025, Mr. Campbell attended the Superintendent's Executive Committee meeting on July 11 via zoom and on August 8, 2025, at Dublin Embassy Suites. He also attends the Budget Symposium on August 6 and Superintendent Conference on August 7 at Embassy Suites Dublin. Topics of discussion were revision to condense county board administration resolution of complaints, DODD switch from Support Intensity Scale assessment to InterRAI, Department of Children and Youth grant agreement for Early Intervention Service Coordination, Biennial Budget and legislature push to override Governor's vetoes, Basic Employment Skills Training in fourth and final revision, and Station MD has virtual assistance for people with disabilities.

The Service and Support Administration department lost two staff; one moved to a part-time position as a Service and Support Administrative Assistant and the other as an Intervention Specialist at Carroll Hills School. There have been many rule changes and added responsibilities to the SSA job description. The proposed InterRAI assessment will mean the Board will have an increased cost to at least share a staff through Mid-East Ohio Regional Council to complete these assessments. The Ohio Individual Service Plan had more twenty-three questions added in discovery assessment and two new assessments monitoring mental health and dementia which are required by the Federal Government.

- Approved payment of June bills in the General Funds account in the amount of \$36,840.99.
- Approved payment of June bills in the Residential Services account in the amount of \$195,261.82.
- Approved payment of July bills in the General Funds account in the amount of \$107,709.24.
- Approved payment of July bills in the Residential Services account in the amount of \$132,326.60.
- Approved the Program Division Reports as presented.
- Approved five new and eight renewal applications for Family Selected Services.
- Approved the CCBDD Local Funding/Supported Living Contract for independent and agency providers.
- Entered executive session 6:21 pm to consider the employment of a public employee or official. Exited at 6:32 pm with no action.
