At the regular May meeting held on May 25, 2022 at Board conference room. Mr. Campbell attended the Superintendent Executive Committee meeting on May 18, 2022 at the Hilton Columbus at Easton and the Ohio Association of County Boards spring conference on May 19 and 20. Superintendent Executive Committee topics were new Early Intervention credentials, options for multi-system youth, 6.5% proposal is at Centers for Medicaid and Medicare Services for approval, legislative meetings, and summer conference. Ohio Association of County Boards Spring conference tracts attended were wearable technology, human trafficking, talent management and succession planning, budgeting, collaboration across counties, self-direction, OhioRise, and legal updates.

The Board has a floor of sixty-three Individual Options Waivers and five Level One Waivers. The Board's set ceiling is eighty-two Individual Options Waivers, fifty Level One Waivers, and four Self Empowered Life Funding Waivers. The Board currently has eighty-four Individual Options, forty-five Level One, and three Self Empowered Life Funding Waivers. The current waiting list consists of six people. Number one on the Board's waiting list needs the Individual Option Waiver due to health of aging care giver. The Board also has an immediate need for additional services.

The Board posted for an additional Service and Support Administrator and a Developmental Specialist. The Board also posted internally for an additional job coach. All these positions are due to serving more individuals and needing to keep caseloads manageable.

Mr. Campbell presented the monthly Major Unusual Incident report for April 2022. There was one alleged verbal abuse, one alleged neglect, one exploitation, one significant injury, and three unanticipated hospitalizations. So, there was seven Major Unusual Incidents in April and nineteen year to date.

In other business, the Board:

- Approved payment of April bills in the Hot Lunch Funds in the amount of \$819.93;
- Approved payment of the April bills in the General Funds account in the amount of \$71,438.11;
- Approved payment of April bills in the Residential Services account in the amount of \$162,394.58;
- Approved resolution 512022 to renew the Carroll Hills School levy;
- Approved two additional Individual Options Waivers that are above the set ceiling of eighty-two;
- Approved five new applications for Family Selected Services;
- approved the program division/committee reports;
- entered executive session at 6:35 pm to consider the employment of a public employee or public official and exited at 6:54 pm. There was no further official action by the Board other than adjournment.
