At the regular February meeting held on February 24, 2022 at Board conference room. Mr. Campbell attended the Superintendent Executive Committee meeting via Zoom on 2-11-2022 at 9:00 am. Jan Dougherty from Association of People Supporting Employment First presented on their efforts to eliminate sub minimum wage for people with disabilities nationally. Ohio Association of County Boards is still promoting the competency based add on revision for direct support professionals. The Ohio Individual Service Plan is up and running using the Salesforce platform. This will be rolled out to county boards soon. The monthly rate calculator has a temporary fix where providers may enter hours that equals the actual ratios to get proper billing.

January 1, 2022 Carroll County Board of Developmental Disabilities entered into an agreement with Ohio Network for Innovation (ONI) to provide administrative services for five residential properties for people with disabilities. ONI is a nonprofit organization that holds the titles for residence who have disabilities and will seek Ohio Department of Developmental Disability and the State of Ohio grants to maintain, purchase new or replacement housing. This transition was necessary when Gateway Housing Opportunities, Inc. nonprofit Board voted to dissolve in December 2021.

Mr. Campbell went over the Employee Engagement survey for 2021 along with the digger deeper questionnaire. It is in the proposed 2022-2024 Strategic Plan to increase scores across each domain annually.

March is DD month. Board members will serve as the Awards Committee by choosing the winners in each category for the 2022 virtual DD Banquet. Award winners will be announced in late March via Facebook and CCBDD website.

9-month school staff have had 12 calamity days. Three of the 12 calamity days for 9-month staff were waived. 9-month staff will make up work four days. Student hours are within the guidelines except for AM Preschool, who will have to make up one day on a Friday.

Mr. Campbell presented the monthly Major Unusual Incident report for January 2022. There was 1 misappropriation and 1 unanticipated hospitalization

In other business, the Board:

- approved the Service and Support Administrative Assistant position with salary range \$24,071 to \$46,005;
- approved the Service and Support Administrative Assistant job description;

- approved the program division/committee reports;
- approved four new and one renewal applications for Family Selected Services.
- Entered executive session at 6:39 pm and exited at 6:43 pm.
