For further information, call Matt Campbell, Superintendent, at 330-627-6555. At the regular June meeting held on June 24, 2021 at Board training room. Mr. Campbell attended a collaborative housing meeting for multisystem youth on June 15, 2021 with Tuscarawas, Knox, and Coshocton County Board superintendents.

Mr. Campbell had a yearly meeting with Executive Director Cathy Henthorn and Steve Long Director of Operations from Mid-East Ohio Regional Council (MEORC). The COVID-19 pandemic caused the Board to look at how to operate with employees working from home. Mr. Campbell requested MEORC staff assistance with a remote workforce review. The Board is looking at MEORC services for Special Olympics coordinator along with other options.

Mr. Campbell reported the following statements were copied from a memo provided by the County Commissioners Association of Ohio (CCAO). Governor DeWine has issued a statement indicating, in part "Pursuant to statute, I also appoint and recommend Juneteenth, June 19, as a state holiday. I also support the legislative efforts to commemorate Juneteenth in the Ohio Revised Code." Based upon the actions of Governor DeWine, consistent with R.C. 325.19, Juneteenth is a holiday for county employees. Mr. Campbell reported Carroll County Commissioners had surveyed local departments on options to make up this holiday this year. He did some research by talking to an attorney on Board options. The Board may honor the Holiday and give staff an alternate day off with or without pay or do nothing at this time. The legislature has not officially adopted a bill to codify the Holiday. Mr. Campbell recommended the Board recognize July 2, 2021 as day to pay staff to be off in honor of Juneteenth.

Mr. Campbell presented the monthly Major Unusual Incident report for May as emailed from Mid-East Ohio Regional Council. There were 4 MUIs in April and 27 year to date.

Business Manager reported sending out contracts to Carrollton Exempted Village School District, Brown Local, Minerva, Sandy Valley, and Conotton Valley School for renewal to pay for aide, speech therapy, physical therapy, occupational therapy, and visual therapy services. He also sent out contracts to Starlight Enterprises Incorporated, Carroll Hills Industries, Mayle Homes, and St. John's Villa to renew agreement to pay for two days a week for individuals without Waiver funding for adult day services.

In other business, the Board:

- approved payment of \$712.78 for May bills in the Hot Lunch account;
- approved payment of \$27,012.62 for May bills in the General Funds account;
- approved payment of \$19,538.48 for May bills in the Residential Services account;
- approved the revised Community Network Coordinator job description;
- approved the program division/committee reports;
- entered executive session at 6:04 pm to consider the employment of a public employee or official and exited at 7:15 pm.
