

Carroll County Board of Developmental Disabilities

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At the regular June meeting held on June 23, 2022 at Board conference room. Mr. Campbell had a yearly meeting with Executive Director Cathy Henthorn and Steve Long Director of Operations from Mid-East Ohio Regional Council (MEORC) on 6-16-2022. This meeting was to discuss products that were purchased and the plan to purchase products from MEORC for 2023 and 2024. Products purchased includes accreditation mastery, eligibility, major unusual incident investigations, nursing quality assessment reviews, payee ship administration, provider compliance reviews, provider support coordination, reporting service coordination, strategic plan development and implementation, wait list assessment, and provider catalog services.

The Board's set ceiling is eighty-two Individual Options Waivers, fifty Level One Waivers, and four Self Empowered Life Funding Waivers. The Board currently has eighty-six Individual Options, forty-four Level One, and three Self Empowered Life Funding Waivers. The current waiting list consists of three people. Mr. Campbell reported the need for another emergency Individual Options Waiver.

Mr. Campbell presented the monthly Major Unusual Incident report for May 2022. There was one accidental/suspicious death, one alleged physical abuse, one verbal abuse, one alleged neglect, one medical emergency and two unanticipated hospitalizations. So, there was seven Major Unusual Incidents in May and twenty-six year to date.

In other business, the Board:

- Approved payment of May bills in the Hot Lunch Funds in the amount of \$446.11;
- Approved payment of the May bills in the General Funds account in the amount of \$66,377.49;
- Approved payment of May bills in the Residential Services account in the amount of \$17,609.62;
- Approved an additional Individual Options Waivers that are above the set ceiling of eighty-two;
- approved the program division/committee reports;
- there was no executive session.
