At the regular March meeting held on March 25, 2021 at Board training room. Mr. Campbell attended the Superintendent Executive Committee meeting on March 12, 2021 at 9 am via Zoom. Merakey staff presented on multisystem youth services they provide. Kristen Henry the executive director of APSI presented on current caseloads and capacity for new guardianship cases. Director Davis reported Level 1 and SELF Waivers are moving forward to make as similar as possible for Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services renewal. Combining the Waivers will be looked at in the future due to the Ohio Department of Medicaid not having time to address this year.

Mr. Campbell attended the Service and Support Administrator (SSA) Director Statewide workgroup via Zoom on March 4, 2021. Jared from the Spirit Club fitness presented on exercise programs for everyone regardless of ability. Ohio Department of Developmental Disabilities staff discussed compliance expectations for person centeredness during this pandemic and with current vaccines. The Ball versus Kasich lawsuit settlement did not cover people with disabilities in nursing homes. Disability Rights Ohio will be interviewing people in nursing homes about their service needs. Willie Jones reported Phase 1-B vaccine County Board contacts made 24,537, number of people declined 7,558, number of people vaccinated with at least one shot 15,126.

The Ohio Department of Developmental Disabilities analyzed state fiscal year 2021 data related to notification to the Local Educational Authority of children potentially eligible for Part B services. Carroll County Board of Developmental Disabilities provides Early Intervention services for children 0 to 2 years old. Before they turn 3 years old the report stated the Board has 100% compliance with notifying local school districts of where the child resides for future services.

Mr. Campbell presented the monthly Major Unusual Incident report for February as emailed from Mid-East Ohio Regional Council. There were 9 MUIs in February and 9 year to date.

In other business, the Board:

- approved payment of \$457.39 for February bills in the Hot Lunch account;
- approved payment of \$27,729.43 for February bills in the General Funds account;
- approved payment of \$14,719.05 for February bills in the Residential Services account;
- approved extending the Families First Coronavirus Response Act (FFCRA) paid leave until September 30, 2021;
- approved the program division/committee reports;
- approved revisions to the Personnel Policy Manual;
- entered executive session at 6:04 pm to consider compensation of a public employee or official and exited at 6:15 pm.
