At the regular November meeting held on November 15, 2022 at the Board conference room. Mr. Campbell reported the Board currently has no immediate needs and only five on the current needs list. The Board set ceiling of 82 IO, 50 Level 1, and 4 SELF Waivers. The Board currently has 87 IO, 42 Level 1, and 3 SELF Waivers.

Election results for our 1.0 Mill School levy. 55.7% voter turnout of 10,198 votes cast. Registered voters are 18,318. For the Tax Levy 6,279 at 63.77% and against the Tax Levy 3,568 at 36.23%. A big thank you to Carroll County voters for once again supporting Carroll Hills School!

Mr. Campbell received notification from Director of Educational Services Ryan Buck that The Ohio Department of Developmental Disabilities completed a fiscal year 2022 review of Early Intervention data. The Early Intervention program was found to be in 100% compliance with the Timely Receipt of Services.

Business Manager Ray Heaston went over the 2023 Operating Budget.

The Board hired a new Service and Support Administrator Amber Hutchison, who started on November 7, 2022.

In other business, the Board:

- Approved payment of October bills in the Hot Lunch account in the amount of \$15.75.
- Approved payment of October bills in the General Funds account in the amount of \$107,076.69.
- Approved payment of October bills in the Residential Services account in the amount of \$149,957.90.
- Approved Resolution 1112022 for the 2023 Operating Budget in the amount of \$5,427,700.
- Approved Resolution 1122022 for the Non-Federal Share of Medicaid Expenditures in the amount of \$900,000.
- Approved twelve staff moonlighting letters.
- Approved the program division/committee reports.
- Approved the Ethics Council recommendation of one new application for Family Selected Services.
- There was no executive session.
