At the regular October meeting held on October 24, 2024, Mr. Campbell attended the Superintendent Executive Committee Meeting on October 11, 2024, via Zoom. The Ohio Department of Developmental Disabilities provided updates on the new waiting list rule will go into effect November 1, with training to be announced soon. They are working on Major Unusual Incident rule update. January 1, 2025, two new Waivers services of health care services and Non-Medical Transportation rate for community integration employment. Provider compliance looking at tool for providers that will focus on settings rule. Waiver modernization is moving forward with new assessment Support Intensity Scale. The Ohio Association of County Boards provided updates on preparing for the state biennial budget with focus on funding for Early Intervention, county board contributions to Family and Children First Council, and the loss of one-time money.
