At the regular September meeting held on September 29, 2022 at Board conference room. Superintendent Executive Committee was held on September 9, 2022. Main topic of discussion is the biennial budget and how much county boards are willing to offer to increase DSP wages. The push is to get DSP wages up since there is a workforce shortage which is jeopardizing disability services. The ongoing increase currently is 6.5% for county boards. A survey was sent out to see how much each county board can afford above the 6.5%. The current 6.5% costs Carroll County Board of DD an additional \$182,082 per year.

Business Manager Ray Heaston went over the report from County Employee Benefits Consortium of Ohio (CEBCO). Carroll County will have a 13% increase in major medical insurance premiums. This will be an increase to the County Board of \$54,000. The Board has picked up the increase for the last thirteen years. Employees share currently is 7.05%.

In other business, the Board:

- Approved payment of August bills in the General Funds account in the amount of \$188,989.88.
- Approved payment of August bills in the Residential Services account in the amount of \$13,641.64.
- Approved resolution 912022 to increase employee share for major medical insurance coverage from 7.05% to 10% due to rate increase of 13%.
- Approved Carroll County Board of Developmental Disabilities 2022 to 2023 School year bus routes.
- Approved an additional Individual Options Waiver to address the need of an individual on the Carroll County waiting list.
- approved the program division/committee reports;
- approved two letters from staff regarding outside employment otherwise known as moonlighting.
- approved the Ethics Council recommendation of five new and three renewal applications for Family Selected Services
- there was no executive session.
